

# Viewing Values and Parcel Information in the CAPture Portal

To view Value and BOE Property Information go to <https://eringcapture.jccal.org> and select Real Property Search.



## Real Property Search

Search and view details related to real property in Jefferson County. Details include property valuation, tax information, land and building details, deed information, building sketches and GIS maps.

Jefferson County Real Property Search allows you to search for parcel information by Property Address, Mailing Address, Owner, and Parcel.



To search by Property Address – enter the street number and then street name.

To search by Mailing Address – enter the street number and then street name.

To search by Name – enter the last name and then the first name.

To search by Parcel – enter the parcel without spaces.

Example Parcel: 22 00 25 3 025 001.000

Enter in search bar with no spaces or periods as:

- 2200253025001000
- Click search\Magnifying Glass
- You get the following parcel:

## Parcel number breakdown:

**22 00 25 3 025 001.000**

<b>Name</b>	<b>Description</b>
Township	<b>22</b> is the Township locator in which the section number is located. Will be a double-digit number.
Area	<b>00</b> is the Area number and is not used in Jefferson County. Will always be 00
Section	<b>25</b> is the section number Will be a double-digit number
Quarter Section	<b>3</b> is the quarter section number (NE1/4 = 1, NW1/4 = 2, SW1/4 = 3, SE1/4 = 4)  Will be a single digit number
Block	<b>025</b> is the map block number
Parcel	Will be a triple digit number <b>001.000</b> is the parcel number Will be a six-digit number

If there is not a quarter section or a map block, this will be zeroes.
