

Where Can I Register To Vote?

Voter registration is governed in Alabama by state law and the federal National Voter Registration Act (NVRA).

Qualifications –

To register to vote in the State of Alabama, an individual must meet the following qualifications:

- 1) Be a United States citizen
- 2) Reside in Alabama
- 3) At least 18 years old on or before election day
- 4) Has not been barred from voting due to a disqualifying felony conviction
- 5) Has not been declared mentally incompetent by a court

Deadline for registering to vote –

Voter Registration Is closed during the 14 days prior to election day.

How to register to vote –

You may register online electronically, or you can download, print, complete, sign and mail in a State of Alabama Mail-in Voter Registration form at www.alabamavotes.gov. Mail the form to the County Board of Registrars that you reside in.
